Toll sticker ("Vignette") compulsory in Austria.

Dear customers,

Please note that Austrian
highways are subjected to road tolls. It
is therefore mandatory for all the vehicles using Austrian
Highway to pay the road toll. Please remember to buy road
toll sticker called Vignette. These toll stickers can be bought
from all gas stations and restaurants which are located
close to the Austrian border

Vehicles found driving on Austrian Highway without this road toll sticker could be charged a minimum fine of €120,00 and an additional administration fee of €39,00. We would therefore advice all our customers to buy the road toll sticker as soon as possible before crossing the German border.

Following are the costs for the time bound road toll stickers:

Please note the traffic rules and regulations in Austria

To ensure that you do not face any problems regarding traffic rules and regulations in Austria please note the following:

- Maximum speed limit allowed on the highways is 130 km/h, and inside built-up areas the maximum speed limit is 50 km/h Note: On highways A10,

Note: On highways A10, A14, A13 and A14 between 10 pm and 5 am, it is not allowed to drive faster than 110 km/h



- The Blood-Alcohol limit in Austria is 0.5 per mill. For drivers who have been driving for less than two years, meaning driving license less than two years old the blood alcohol limit is 0.1 per mill.
- All passengers must wear seat belts.
- All children 150 cm tall or under 14 years of age must be seated on a child seat.
- Warning vest, warning sign triangle and first aid box are mandatory to be carried in car.
- Additional fees or charges may apply depending on specific tunnels or mountain passes.
